The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Committee is part of the Council of Catholic School Parents NSW/ACT. The committee was established in December 2003 to provide meaningful Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander parent representation at a state level. This unique group aims to build home, school and community partnerships by providing valuable information, advocating for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander parents, and developing resources. Parent representatives are supported by an executive officer employed by their diocese.
